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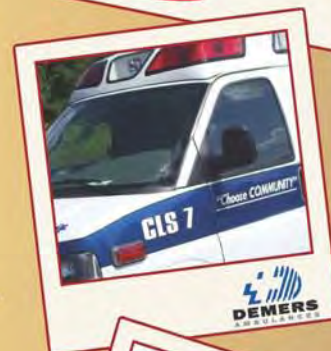
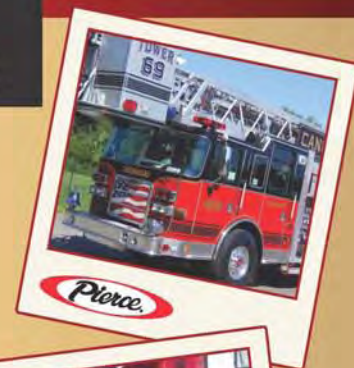
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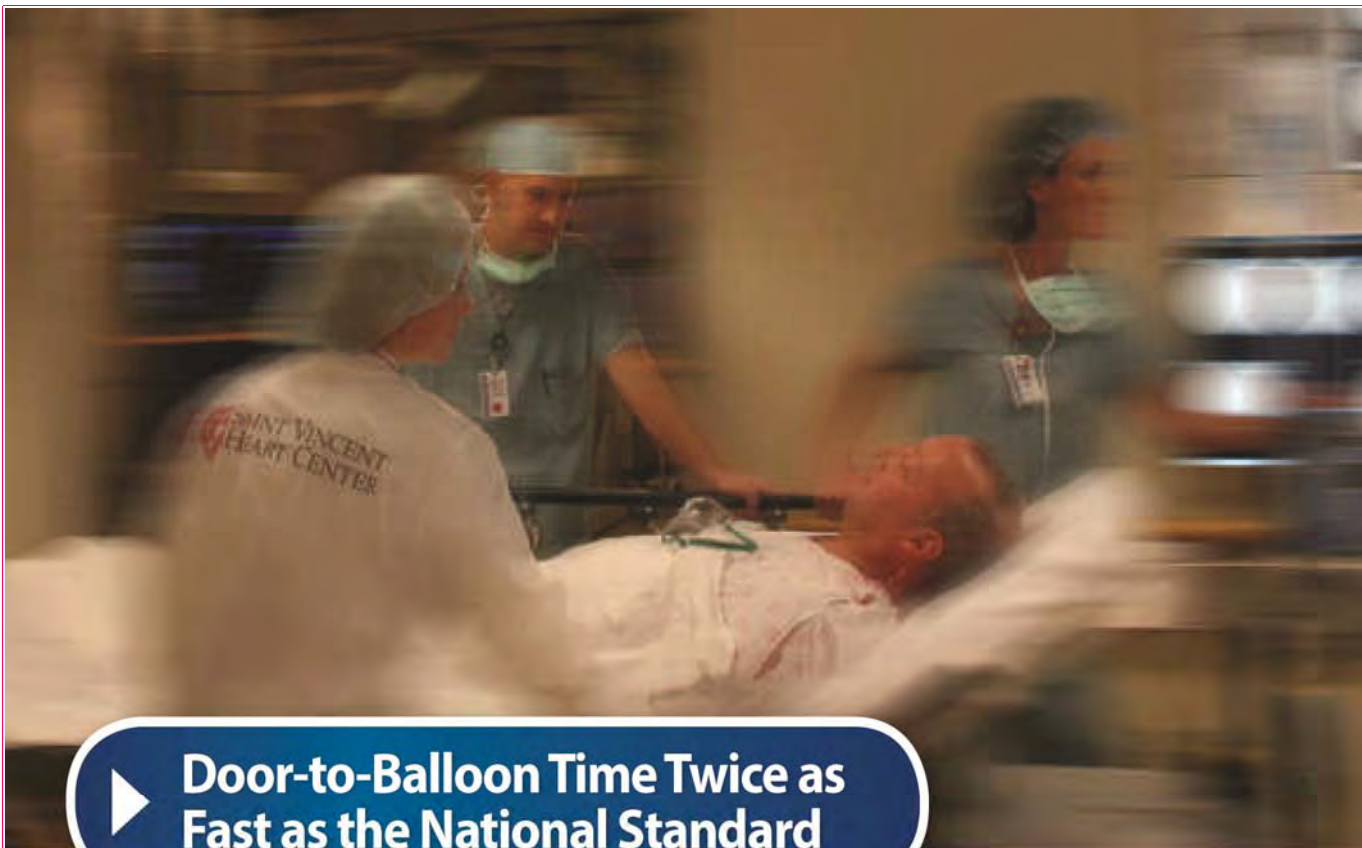


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▶ Door-to-Balloon Time Twice as Fast as the National Standard

When it comes to the partnership between area EMS and the Saint Vincent Heart and Vascular Center, success is easy to measure.

In 2012, the Saint Vincent HeartSTAT team of expert physicians, nurses and technicians lowered the average door-to-balloon time to 43 minutes, a full 47 minutes faster than the national standard. In one case, the door-to-balloon time was only 21 minutes.

EMS also played a significant role in this accomplishment. Most EMTs in the region have participated in training to recognize a STEMI and notify Saint Vincent in advance that a STEMI case is on the way. That enables the Saint Vincent HeartSTAT team to mobilize and be ready and waiting when the patient arrives.

On behalf of the HeartSTAT team and the patients whose lives – and quality of life – have been saved, we thank you for being a part of this significant accomplishment.
