**For all priorities:**

For each piece of equipment that EMSOF funding is requested for, demonstration must be shown that the service has a need for the equipment. For example: do not have, out dated, broken, repairs to costly to keep in service, etc.

Recruitment and Retention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Funding is available for activity in recruiting and retaining a service's members. A contract will be provided for this priority. <u>Clear goals for the project must be included with appendix A.</u> On appendix A list what you would like EMSOF funding for and estimated total cost for each.</li> <li>Fundable items are as follows <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Professionally done brochures or posters</li> <li>Purchase of professionally done video on recruitment and retention which is EMS related</li> <li>Lodging costs are limited to \$75.00+tax per night</li> <li>Speaker on subject to teach service or to speak to groups on behalf of the service. May include mileage at the prevailing rate per mile, speaker/consultant fee, meals for overnight travel and other subsistence expenses is allowed at a maximum of \$35.00 for each 24 hour period spent in continuous overnight travel status. The 24 hour period begins at any time of the day or night that the contractor leaves headquarters or residence on official business. This includes tips.</li> <li>Advertising for personnel which may include newspaper, radio, or television, or a portable sign rental</li> <li>Scholarships/tuition reimbursement for the first responder, emergency medical technician or paramedic education. (new this year)</li> </ul> </li> <li>If you have other program related expenses that you would like considered for funding, contact EMMCO West for approval <b>PRIOR</b> to expenditure.</li> </ul>	Approved cost
Merger or consolidation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Costs associated with investigating a potential merger or consolidation of services or the actual merger or consolidation of services. These costs may include but are not</li> </ul>	

limited to: consulting fees, studies, legal fees, and statistical analysis. EMMCO West must be included in the meetings and discussions of this merger or consolidation of services. A list of expenses must be provided to EMMCO West and a contract will be provided to the services involved.	Approved cost
Written test for EMT/First Responder (100% EMSOF) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Department of Health will reimburse a service up to \$100.00 for each written exam up to a maximum of two or \$200.00 for each student.</li> </ul>	\$200.00
Automatic external Defibrillator <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please be advised that it is the intention of EMMCO West to purchase only one kind of AED. This AED may not be the same type that you currently own. If you want only one particular brand of AED, you should seek other funding sources.</li> <li>Services that have never been approved by EMMCO West as an AED provider MUST be approved prior to receiving funding. If your service is interested in receiving EMSOF funding for an AED and have not already been approved as an AED provider, all the necessary documentation is available on the website <a href="http://www.emmco.org">www.emmco.org</a> under licensure. <sup>4</sup> Funding priority for monitor/defibrillator

1. Documentation is required for a monitor/defibrillator with history of maintenance problems. Service must have a maintenance agreement with an authorized dealer for their monitor/defibrillator. This agreement must have been in effect for at least one year. A copy of this agreement must be returned with request for funding.
2. Licensed ALS services that have a BLS ambulance that they would like to bring up to ALS standards
3. ALS services with a monitor/defibrillator older than 8 years, 7 years, 6 years then 5 years
4. ALS services that are requesting funding for a 12 lead monitor/defibrillator that have a system in place to incorporate this equipment into the hospital system will be taken into consideration first for funding in conjunction with 1, 2 and 3 above. Describe in writing how your service accomplishes this. Within your justification for a monitor/defibrillator describe the condition of the monitor/defibrillator to be replaced and the age of the unit. Be sure to include a copy of the current service agreement with a factory authorized service representative if requesting funding for a replacement monitor/defibrillator.
5. Before applying for ALS equipment or ALS vehicles, your service must be approved and licensed as an ALS service by EMMCO West, Inc.
