#### **PCR Data**

911 Calls – only using PCR data which states "911 Response"

Busiest time of the day for EMS calls is between 1500 and 1759 with 16.5%. That is followed by  $1800 - 2059 \ (16.3\%)$ ,  $2100 - 2359 \ (15.8\%)$ ,  $1200 - 1459 \ (14.1\%)$ ,  $0000 - 0259 \ (12.6\%)$ ,  $0300 - 0559 \ (9.6\%)$ ,  $0900 - 1159 \ (7.9\%)$  and  $0900 - 1159 \ (7.2\%)$ 

Intercept – only using PCR data which states "Intercept"

Busiest time of the day for EMS calls is between 1500 and 1759 with 18.9%. That is followed by 2100 - 2359 (18.1%), 1200 - 1459 (16.0%), 1800 - 2059 (15.8%), 0000 - 0259 (14.3%), 0300 - 0559 (6.4%), 0900 - 1159 (6.3%), and 0600 - 0859 (4.1%)

Busiest day of the week is Monday, followed by Tuesday.

79.5% of calls are treated, transported by EMS. Nearly 2.9% of the patients seen (according to PCRs) require no treatment. 6.8% of the patients (again, according to PCRs) refuse care.

31.9% of patient destination basis is by patient choice. 19.2% of the time it is based on closest facility and 1.7% of patients are transported to a destination based on patient's physician choice. 1.6% of the patients are transported to specialty resource centers.

Staff participated in 0 PCR vendor roll-outs.

EMMCO West is overseeing the development and implementation of a statewide cloud-based PCR data management process. The program will provide a seamless transition of PCR data from any approved NEMSIS 3.4 vendor's PCR program to the cloud PCR repository.





#### **Regional Initiatives**

#### Regional Communication Projects \$23,880.00

EMMCO West received requests for EMS communication projects from regional PSAP centers. Two projects were awarded to -

#### Special Projects Assist EMS Agencies - \$52,159.00

- <u>Commercial Tourniquets</u> All licensed EMS agencies in the EMMCO West region will be receiving a 2nd Commercial Tourniquet to meet minimum ambulance licensing standards.
- <u>Pediatric Immobilization Device</u> (PediMate Plus) see photo

EMS agencies that do not yet have a pediatric immobilization device will be eligible to receive a Ferno Washington Pedi-Mate Plus device from EMMCO West.

• <u>Hemostatic Agents</u> - Identified in Protocol 601 Bleeding Control is an optional skill for controlling severe bleeding. EMMCO West will be providing EMS agencies that wish to implement a hemostatic agent program in their EMS agency with hemostatic impregnated dressings.
